Edith Albro, according to legend "Pinky" McCan was "A fine leader with a pleasant personality, a dedicated excellent skilled bowler." Charles Saulsberry added, "This lady was a fine team bowler, not the highest average, but one of the most consistent." Edith's averages were pretty good for the 1930's & 1940's with her 5 highest being: 155, 158, 160, 165, 155. A summary of her accomplishments include:
