Men's Veteran Service – 1998



Jerry was born April 24, 1934 in Oklahoma City and been here his entire life. He has been a sanctioned bowler for 38 years. He is described as having a pleasing personality, very easy to get along with and his leadership is shown in the number of leagues he has held office in as President or Secretary. He is a very dedicated bowler in 5 or 6 leagues. He began bowling in 1959 and worked at Windsor Lanes in 1977-1978 as a night manager. He began the YBA program at Windsor Lanes in 1964. He was elected to the Oklahoma City Men's Bowling Association as Associate Director in 1987-88. He currently is serving as President of the Oklahoma City Bowling Council and helps Harwell Heare, Association Secretary performing yearly lane inspections of all 14 houses. This means crawling under all 382 lanes to look for repairs, check measurements and depth perceptions of each lane. He also helps prepare and deliver to league supplies to each center for new season. He has been instrumental in repairing the association office, replacing south wall that had deteriorated. Woody Baker said he could easily be nominated for the Skill Division as well, but in his opinion, the Service is more important as he is a past President that never quits working.
