Sharon, born in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma has been a sanctioned bowler for 49 years, first in Colorado, then New Mexico and the last 44 years in Oklahoma City. She is widowed, having lost her long-time companion Fred just before last year's induction ceremony. They had 2 boys, Chip and Brett (both bowlers), 3 grandchildren and 2 great grandchildren. Sharon is an Assistant Librarian in the OKC Public School system. She began her bowling service career as a Director in the OCWBA 22 years ago. During that course, she served on most all committees, nominating and Hall of Fame committees. She has been the Secretary of the Bowling Council the past 8 years. She has been a certified Lane Inspector for 16 years – one of the first female inspectors in OKC. She received her 25 year participation plaque for bowling in that many National Tournaments and representing OKC as a Delegate. She served 20 years as an OWBA Delegate and 16 times as a Delegate to the WIBC National Convention. Sharon is a very active bowler, bowling in several different centers and also has been a league officer in many. While service is her forte', she manages a respectful High Average of 173; High Series 632; High Game 279. She won 1st Place Team in 1997 OKC Tournament, 1st Class B Doubles in 1991 OKC Tournament and 2nd Place Division 1 in Oklahoma State Tournament.
