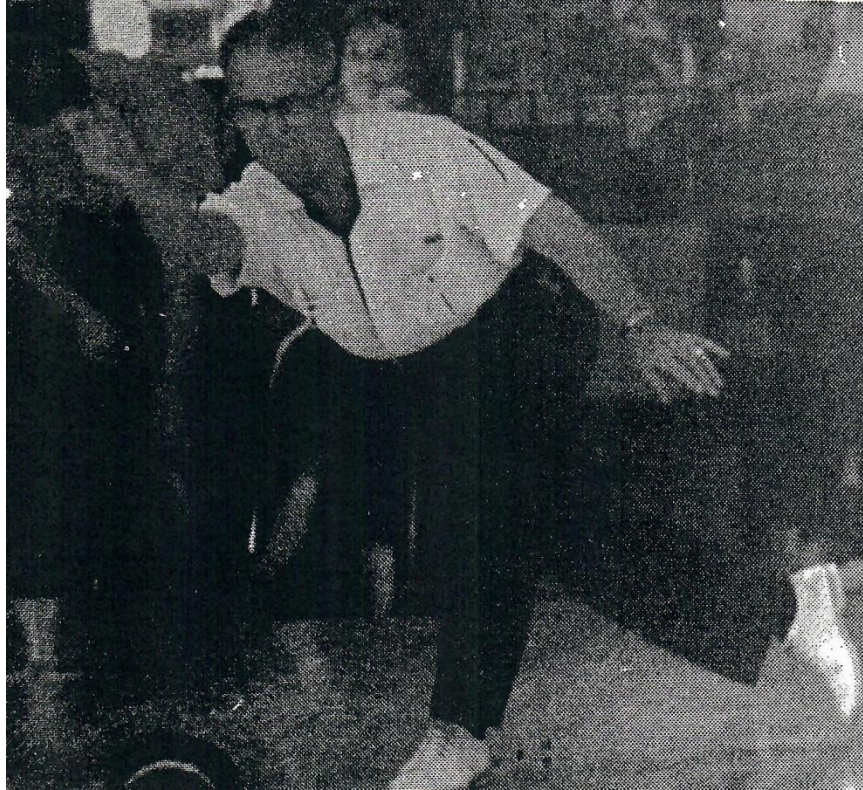


PETE GRANT
