Allison G. Johnson, 41, Oklahoma born, started bowling at age 5 at Sunnyslane Bowling Center in Del City. Her YABA career included Female Western Triple Crown Champion, 1990 YABA Female Bowler of the Year. At age 22, Allison shot her first 300 Game as part of a Mixed Doubles Team with Robert Grimmitt who had a 299 Game. Their 599 Series was the Nation's record for a Mixed Doubles Score in 1994, and also the year's highest Double Score shared with 2 Male Double Teams. The score also gave Allison the first ever ABC Fiscal Year Award for Women. Allison has a High League Average of 223 and has scored Two 800 Series, 828 & 809. She has bowled Four 300 Games and Five Games with 11-in-a-Row. Allison has consistently been ranked in Oklahoma City's yearly "Top 20" averages. What sets Allison apart is her character traits, her outgoing personality, fun to be around, leadership as Youth Director and 18 years work with Special Olympics, dedicated to the sport of bowling by continuing to improve her game and understanding the rules of the game. Allison has bowled professionally and has been in the top 24 of a Ladies Professional Bowlers Tour Event and has 2 Top 10 finishes in LPBT Regional Events. The Oklahoma City Hall of Fame is proud to induct Allison Johnson into its Hall of Fame.
