Born in Okmulgee, Oklahoma, Rheba has been in the Oklahoma City area for 34 years. She has been a sanctioned bowler 22 years. Her highest 5 averages with 60 or more games are: 190, 187, 185, 184, and 183. Her high game is 279 and high series is 710. Rheba is considered one of the Top Team bowlers in Oklahoma City. She has won many awards for both individual and team in league play. She has been a member of the Oklahoma State Champion Team 5 times. She has won the Women's Double Elimination Tournament in Tulsa. She was a member of the Team Champion in Shrine Tournament in OKC, Doubles Champ and All Events Scratch in Shrine Tournament in Wichita. She had high 3 game series for women in OKC in 1962. When OKC had a televised bowling show in the 1950's, Rheba bowled on that program for 9 weeks before being defeated. She was selected as Bowler of the Year in 1961-62, averaging 190, 187 and 187 in 3 leagues. She is a member of the Oklahoma City 600 Club and the Mersfelders 700 Club. Rheba was also a member of the Professional Womens Bowling Association for 3 years. For her ability and skill as a bowler and her dedication to the game of bowling the Oklahoma City Bowling Council proudly inducts Rheba Martin into its Bowling Hall of Fame.
