

MIKE SHROPSHIRE

Men's Veteran Skill – 1994



Mike started bowling at age 5. He set pins at Jenks-Capitol Sport Center at age 9. He worked on the machines at Holiday Lanes in the 1960's. He worked the control desk at Hilander in 1962 and 1963. In 1959 and 1960 he was a league officer of the only Junior Traveling league in Oklahoma City. His high average is 209 and high series is 770. Although he bowled a 300 in 1963 at Hilander in Jackpot, his high sanctioned game is 290. In 1960, he won All Events in the Oklahoma City Men's Association Tournament at the age of SIXTEEN! He bowled on a team in 1969-70 that won First and Second 4-Man Team Series and 3rd High Game in the Nation. Bowling with him then were Richard Altman, Steve Carson and Jim Cork. It is with pleasure that we induct Mike Shropshire into the Greater Oklahoma City Bowling Hall of Fame.
