

MARIAN SPENCER

Women's Skill Division – 1985



Ms. Spencer was a sanctioned bowler for 21 years, 20 of those years were in the Oklahoma City area. Her five highest averages ranged from 186 to 196 with a high scratch game of 278 and a scratch 727 series. She received many league awards both individually and with her team. Her tournament honors include: Winner of Oklahoma State Queens Tournament in 1965 and 1966; Runner-Up National WIBC Queens Tournament in 1967; National WIBC Doubles in 1967; Green Country Tournament All Events in 1975 as well as a member of the winning team in 1975. In 1967, Ms. Spencer and her doubles partner bowled a single game of 523 in the WIBC National Tournament. This game was the 4th all-time record at that time. Their 1315 series was the 6th all-time record up to that time.

For her consistent high averages both in league and tournament competition, and her exceptional match game and one on one competition, we proudly induct Marian Spencer into the Oklahoma City Hall of Fame. We regret to make the award posthumously and extend our sympathy to her family.
