Jim Thomas, age 50, has been bowling in sanctioned league over 30 years and fourteen in the Oklahoma City area. He has held the most 200 averages over the 30 years of bowling over any others in the state. For a number of years Jim traveled from Enid to Oklahoma City to bowl so that he could have a chance to bowl against the best in the state. In Enid he won City Tournament Singles, Doubles, Team, All Events and Scratch All Events (5 titles in one tournament). At the old Del Lanes in Del City, Oklahoma, Jim won the \$1000 Singles Classic with the first 1900 series for an 8 game tournament across 16 lanes in the United States. He has won too many tournaments to list but has represented the State of Oklahoma with great pride for many years and will continue to do so. One summer in Dallas, Texas while bowling with the likes of Bill Lillard, Tony Lindeman Jim carried a 219 league average. The league was mixed with pros and amateurs and was not a sanctioned league. Jim has bowled two 300 Games, tow 298 Games and Two 290 Games. His high series is an 805. For his many years as a top bowler and is dedication to the game the Oklahoma City Bowling Council is proud to induct Jim Thomas into its Oklahoma City Bowling Hall of Fame.
