Born in Oklahoma City, Martha “Skinny” Tippet was a sanctioned bowler for 20 years. Skinny was an exceptional bowler in her time with a high game of 281 and high series of 682. She won the Doubles Elimination Tournament in Tulsa, the Harpman Tournament in Oklahoma City and placed in many other tournaments. She was involved as league officer, league director or team captain in about every league she bowled. She was one of the many dedicated women bowlers in Oklahoma City for 20 years. She was Secretary of 3 leagues 5 years straight. She placed 5th in Singles at WIBC National Tournament in Kansas City. She was also a member of the 600 Club. The Oklahoma City Bowling Council proudly inducts Martha “Skinny” Tippet into its Bowling Hall of Fame.
