Born in Oklahoma City, Robert (Bob) spent his life here in the metro area and has been a sanctioned bowler for 23 years. He has been described as being dedicated to the game of bowling, an efficient league secretary, a fine detail man on tournaments and an experienced youth coach and instructor. For 21 years, Robert has been the Secretary of the Southside Church League, 17 years a member of the Oklahoma City Men's Bowling Association, 11 years a member of the Southwest Bowling Association and 16 years served as coach/instructor in the YBA program at Penn 44 Lanes. While a member of the Oklahoma City Men's Association, he served as follows:

1972-1973	1 year as President
1973-1976	3 years as Ex-officio
1976-1981	5 years as Director
