Rhonda is disciplined, focused and a highly competitive bowler who has consistently been one of the top women bowlers in the OKC area. Bowling in as many as four leagues a week, her average since 1999-2000 has been well over 200 with a 217 high in 2000. That year as well as her 208 average in 2004-05 earned her Bowler of the Year as Top Female Average in OKC. Last season, Rhonda bowled an 823 Series, an Oklahoma City record high series for women in league play. She has bowled Four 300 Games, One 299 Game and Six 11-in-a-Row Games. Raised in Guthrie, Oklahoma, the youngest of four brothers and two sisters, Rhonda works at Tinker Air Force Base and has three teenage children. Because of her competitiveness and consistent high scoring she is often asked to bowl on tournament teams whose averages are all above 200. Her tournament honors include: 2004 600 Club Champion; 2002 Division I All Events Champion OWBA State; 1997 Division I Doubles Champion OWBA; 2005-06 OCWBA High Series (780); 2002-03 OCWBA High Series (760); 2007-08 USBC High Series 823; Recipient of OCWBA Lifetime Achievement Award for the 217 League High Average in 05-06; Cashed the Oil Capitol, Greater Tulsa Open and Southwest. It is because of her high level of skill, her outgoing personality and dedication to the sport of bowling, the Oklahoma City Bowling Council proudly inducts Rhonda Wright into its Hall of Fame.
