OKLAHOMA STATE HALL OF FAME CRITERIA

SERVICE - Open to any bowler who has worked for the betterment of the game of American Ten Pins for a minimum of twenty (20) years, with a minimum of ten (10) years in the Oklahoma State USBC (formerly Oklahoma B.A. or Oklahoma WIBC). They have made outstanding contributions to the good and welfare of the game through administrative or organizational work in any manner deemed meritorious.

SKILL - Open to any bowler who, through their competitive skills, has displayed outstanding ability in the game of American Ten Pins. This skill must be exhibited over a minimum of twenty (20) years as an active bowler with a minimum of ten (10) combined years in the Oklahoma State USBC (formerly Oklahoma B.A. or Oklahoma WIBC) with a minimum of twenty-one (21) certified/sanctioned league games per year.
